- What are two new considerations for small-scale designs that have arisen in recent years?
- Speculate on possible design considerations for small-scale projects that may arise over the next ten years.
- Describe a specific finding presented at the symposium that will directly influence your design practice.
- Were issues raised that you feel require further discussion or exploration?
