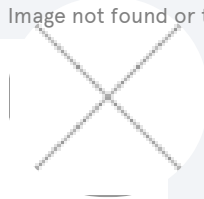
Speakers.

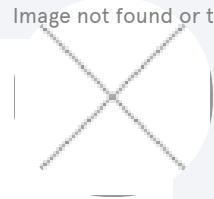


Angelo Candalepas
